

Australian National Council of Orff Schulwerk

The six Australian state associations (Orff NSW, VOSA, OSASA, TOSA, QOSA & WAOSA) operate independently to promote the Schulwerk in the best ways possible for the members in their region. The Australian National Council of Orff Schulwerk (ANCOS) is the umbrella body which acts as a central advisory, consultative and co-ordination body.

The ANCOS Executive Committee meets twice a year, and is comprised of two representatives from each state association.

Key Functions

Promote the teachings and philosophies of Orff Schulwerk in Australia

Advocate for music education nationally

Maintain connections with Orff Schulwerk associations throughout the world

Monitor and improve the 4 Level Training Courses developed to reflect Australian conditions

Administer the Humphries-Parker-Smith and Donations Funds, established to foster further education or creative projects with an Orff focus

Facilitate the publication of the annual refereed journal *Musicworks*

Co-ordinate visits from overseas presenters

The showcase event, the biennial national conference, is organised by the state organisations on a rotational basis.
