

The Orff Society UK was founded by Margaret Murray MBE (1921-2016) in 1962. It promotes Orff Schulwerk through professional development activities and publications.

We draw on tutors from the UK and from the international network of Orff Schulwerk practitioners to lead and direct workshops and courses aimed at all those who work musically with children. We organise an International Summer School every 2 years.

Members receive the Orff Times which is published twice a year. They also have access to resources on the Society's website. Members receive discounts on fees for workshops and can apply for bursaries to attend courses anywhere in the world.

The Orff Society UK is a member of the Incorporated Society of Musicians and the International Forum for Orff Schulwerk Salzburg.
