The children of my 2nd year class have been used to a hand puppet called "Mimi-Mouse" since they started school and they "insist" on its regular appearance even now. Therefore I used it in the 1st video to give them some feeling of closeness to the normal classroom situation.

Mimi mouse makes a lot of "jokes" also in regular lessons. Since it is actually used to help the children learning to read and write, the poor thing sometimes simply can not calculate and the children have to help it...

The children also play with this puppet and want to have it with them in turn and have a dialogue with it or feed it with cheese from their snack. This means a lot to them. I have now extended this method to the well-known "Kasperl" figures.
